Feral Cat Voucher Program: Contracted municipalities provide vouchers for free surgery. Check first with your local government to see if these vouchers are available. If your municipality is not contracted with the HSHA, you can use the general surgery clinic option. If you have received a voucher for a free surgery from a contracted municipality, call the HSHA at 717-564-3320, Option 2. You will need to present the voucher and a legal photo ID at the time of the surgery. (The Nobody's Cats Foundation accepts vouchers at its clinic; see details below.) Humane traps available for loan.

Cat Spay/Neuter Clinic: Surgeries for cats (a minimum of 4-5 months of age and no older than 7 years of age) are available for \$45 for neuters and \$65 for spays. Proof of vaccinations (rabies and distemper combination) must be provided or cats will receive vaccines for an additional \$10.
