Volunteering for the foundation is a privilege. A volunteer's first ninety (90) days of service are on a trial basis, following successful completion of any necessary training. This allows the volunteer and the foundation to assess the appropriateness of the fit between the volunteer's interest, skills, and abilities and the mission, values, and work of the foundation. If it is determined by either party during the 90-day probationary period that volunteer work for the foundation is not appropriate, termination can be immediate and without notice or reason provided by either party. The foundation receives the right to perform background checks on any potential volunteer as a requirement for volunteering.
