Feral Cat Voucher Program: Contracted municipalities provide vouchers for free surgery. Check first with your local government to see if these vouchers are available. If you have received a voucher for a free surgery from a contracted municipality, call the HSHA at 717-564-3320, Option 2. You will need to present the voucher and a legal photo ID at the time of the surgery. (The Nobody's Cats Foundation accepts vouchers at its clinic; see details below.) Humane traps available for loan.

Cat Spay/Neuter Clinic: Surgeries for cats (a minimum of 4-5 months of age and no older than 7 years of age) are available for \$45 for neuters and \$65 for spays. Proof of vaccinations (rabies and distemper combination) must be provided or cats will receive vaccines for an additional \$10.
